Archdiocesan News Without the Standard & Times? An Internet Solution

There are likely many among the readers of this newsletter who miss getting their news of the Archdiocese from the *Catholic Standard & Times*.

If you own and know your way around a personal computer or other device that can access the Internet, you can catch up on some of that missing news. I know this to be true because that is how I found the recent information about clerical changes.

First you need to reach the Archdiocese of Philadelphia website. For those of you reading this on the Internet, you can click on <http://archphila.org/home.php>.

If you use Google or another option to search the Internet, just type in "Archdiocese of Philadelphia". One of the options that should come up is "archphila.org". Select that option.

If you don't regularly search the internet, you can usually type "archphila.org" into the section of your web browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc.) that shows the name of each webpage you visit. This is normally at the top left of your web page.

Once you get to the Archdiocese of Philadelphia website, position your mouse cursor over the word "News" on the second line below the large words Archdiocese of Philadelphia in the center of the web page.

When you position the mouse cursor, but do not

click any mouse buttons, you should see a number of options in a vertical list open up under the word "News". You should then move the mouse cursor down until the words "CatholicPhilly" and "CS&T and Phaith" are highlighted. Then click with the left mouse button so you will be taken to the CatholicPhilly web page. If you are reading this on the Internet, you can click on <http://catholicphilly.com/>.

At this point, if you know how to save or bookmark this website for quick access, you should add it on a bookmark for the future.

The clerical changes are listed if you hold your mouse cursor over "News: on this web page then click on "Archdiocese News".

At this point, you may explore the many things this web site has to offer.
