National Vocation Awareness Week

As described on the website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), National Vocation Awareness Week (NVAW) is an annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promote vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayers and education. It is also a period to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of those particular vocations.

According to the website information, National Vocation Awareness Week began in 1976 when the U.S. bishops designated the 28th Sunday of the year for NVAW. The celebration was moved to coincide with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord in 1997. Then, beginning in 2014, NVAW was moved to the first full week in November.

The USCCB website provided this Prayer for Vocations:

God our Father, we thank you for calling men and women to serve in your Son's Kingdom as priests, deacons, and consecrated persons. Send your Holy Spirit to help others to respond generously and courageously to your call. May our community of Faith support vocations of sacrificial love in our youth and young adults. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever..

Conference & Pilgrimage to the Shrine of St John Neumann

Our region is privileged to be the location of a regional Serra event on November 2, 2019—a Conference and Pilgrimage to the Shrine of St. John Neumann located at the Church of St. Peter the Apostle, 1019 N. 5th Street, Philadelphia, PA 19123. This is an event drawing from Serra clubs of the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic regions of the United States.

Featured will be presentations by author and speaker Christopher de Vink, Serra US Council President Judy Cozzens, and past US Council President Greg Schwietz. There will also be a panel discussion of Saints and Blesseds of the region including St. Katherine Drexel, Blessed Father Stanley Rother, Blessed Father Walter Ciszek, Servants of God Terence Cardinal Cooke, and Father Bill Atkinson, OSA.

There will be time to visit the Shrine, Museum and Gift Shop, as well as have Eucharistic Adoration and a closing Mass. In addition, fellow Serrans and friends will share in three meals during this day.

The \$99 fee for the day includes three meals, handouts, and workshops.
